## Request for Information

Thank you for your email dated 23 November requesting information on de-registrations of Housing Associations. For ease of reference your request is below.

I write to request information under the Freedom of Information Act concerning Housing Associations and the de-registering of Housing Associations.

For 2015:

- 1. a) Please provide a list of all Housing Associations de-registered.
  - b) Please provide the reasons given for each one being de-registered

To provide you with some background the HCA is the national housing and regeneration agency for England and Wales as well as the Social Housing Regulator. The information held by HCA is only that which we need for the purposes of meeting our organisational, statutory and regulatory objectives. We do not hold information for the areas of the UK outside England and Wales, and we only hold information of housing associations that are registered as providers of social housing (known as Registered Providers (RPs)).

Therefore we are able to provide you with a full list of RPs who have de-registered in 2015 and the reasons why in a spread sheet that accompanies this letter. As mentioned above some of the RPs listed will be Housing Associations as per your request; however others will be private RPs, Co-operatives or other types of RPs.
