Dea .

Thank you for your email of 17 February 2016 requesting the following information:

"Under the freedom of information act I would like to request the most recent energy efficient survey and grade assessment survey done for the CAAS and the recent electric test done on the SFA I'm currently living in."

Lam treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence (MOD), and I can confirm that some information in scope of your request is held, and can be found below and at Annex A of this letter.

Under Section 16 of the Act (Advice and Assistance) you may find it helpful to note that your Service Family Accommodation (SFA) was graded using extrapolated information from a cross section of assessments completed on other SFA unit's of equivalent grade in the Gosport area. As a result, there is no independent banding report for your property, other than an assessment of the properties location.

Furthermore the information you request regarding your most recent electrical test is not held. It should be noted, however, that if any serious faults were found during the aforementioned test, rectification work would have been carried out as was practical.

If you are not satisfied with this response or you wish to complain about any aspect of the handling of your request, then you should contact me in the first instance. If informal resolution is not possible and you are still dissatisfied then you may apply for an independent internal review by contacting the Information Rights Compliance tearn, 1st Floor, MOD Main Building, Whitehall, SW1A 2HB (e-mail CIO-FOI-IR@mod.uk). Please note that any request for an internal review must be made within 40 working days of the date on which the attempt to reach informal resolution has come to an end

If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not investigate your case until the MOD internal review process has been completed. 
