FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000: MINISTRY OF DEFENCE POLICE: STATISTICS RELATING TO CRIMES IN SCHOOLS

I write in regards to your email dated 6 May 2015 which was acknowledged on 7 May 2015.

We are treating your email as a request for information in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA 2000).

In your email you requested the following information:

"I should like to request the following crime statistics held by your force relating to crimes on school premises for the period 1 April 2014 – 31 March 2015. If those figures are unavailable I should be grateful for the statistics for the period 1 April 2013 – 31 March 2014. I should prefer to receive this information in electronic format at this email address; however, I am happy to receive the information by post if that would be more convenient."

Information requested:

- The number of offences and the detection rate relating to the burglary of school premises (irrespective of whether the school was open at the time)*
- The number of offences and the detection rate relating to criminal damage to school premises (irrespective of whether the school was open at the time)*
- The number of offences and the detection rate in respect of criminal damage by fire (arson) at school premises (irrespective of whether the school was open at the time)*
- The detection rate relating to the burglary of school premises (irrespective of whether the school was open at the time)*
- The detection rate relating to criminal damage to school premises (irrespective of whether the school was open at the time)*
- The detection rate in respect of criminal damage by fire (arson) at school premises (irrespective of whether the school was open at the time)."*

A search for information has now been completed and I can confirm that information in scope of your request is held.

Please see the table below showing the requested statistics from 1 April 2014 – 31 March 2015.

If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not investigate the case until the MOD internal review process has been completed.
