**DIVERSION ORDER 2013**

This Order is made by Borough of Telford and Wrekin ("the Authority") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the owners of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this order it is expedient that the line of the footpath should be diverted.

Allstair and Catherine Nicoll of Balli-Hi, Red Lake, Kettleby, Telford and Barbara Linning of Wyecroft, Shrubbery Road, Kettleby, Telford have agreed terms to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the way into a fit condition for use by the public.

**BY THIS ORDER:**

1. The public right of way over the land situated near to the property Balli-Hi, Red Lake, Kettleby, Telford and shown by a continuous bold line on the map contained in this order and described in Part 1 of the schedule to this order shall be stopped up after 28 days from the date of confirmation of this order.
2. There shall be created to the reasonable satisfaction of the Authority an alternative footpath for use as a replacement for the said footpath over the strip of land running between Quarry Lane and Shrubbery Lane, Kettleby, Telford as described in Part 2 of the Schedule to this Order and shown by a broken line on the map contained in this order

3. There shall be at the end of 28 days from the date of confirmation of this order a public footpath over the land situated between Quarry Lane and Shrubbery Road, Kettleby, Telford described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a broken line on the map contained in this order ("the Map")

4. The Authority shall not confirm this Order until it has certified that the terms of Article 2 have been complied with.

5. The rights conferred on the public under this order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule

**SCHEDULE**

**PART 1**

**DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY**

From a junction with Shrubbery Road at point A on the map footprint 191 runs in a north easterly direction for approximately 90 metres to a junction with footprint 193 at point B on the map. The route then continues from point B on the map in a north easterly direction for a further 85 metres to a junction with footpaths 197, 194 and restricted byway 196 at point C on the map.

**PART 2**

**DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATH OR WAY**

From point D on the map at the junction with Shrubbery Road the route being a stone surfaced track having an approximate width of 3 metres continues in a general northerly direction for a distance of 64 metres to a wooden kissing gate at point E then continues in a general north-easterly direction as a 1.2 metre wide tarmac path for a further 80 metres to the wooden kissing gate at the junction with Quarry Lane at point F on the map

**PART 3**

**LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS**

The right of the owner and the Authority to erect a kissing gate or a pedestrian friendly barrier at points E and F on the map.
