## BS EN 62676-1-1 – Video surveillance systems for use in security applications, Part 1-1: System requirements – General

This standard gives recommendations for CCTV installed for use in security and specifies minimum requirements. It specifies the minimum performance and functional requirements which should be agreed by the customer and installer as well as law enforcement agencies where needed.

The standard also applies where the system shares detection, triggering, interconnection, control, communication or power supply with another security application such as an intruder alarm system.

It does not include requirements for design, planning, installation, testing, operation or maintenance. The standard also excludes installation of remotely monitored detector activated CCTV.

In particular this standard highlights some of the key features that any good CCTV system should provide, such as effective image export capability and an easily replayable data format, both of which are critical if the pictures may be used as evidence in an investigation.
