



# MGN 472 (M) (CORRIGENDUM)

## Maritime Labour Convention, 2006: Guidance on the procedure for applying for a Substantial Equivalence

Notice to all shipbuilders, shipowners, ship operators, employers, masters, seafarers, manning agents and agencies

*This notice should be read with The Merchant Shipping (Maritime Labour Convention)(Survey and Certification) Regulations 2013 and the Merchant Shipping (Maritime Labour Convention) (Minimum Requirements for Seafarers etc.) Regulations 2014 and Marine Guidance Note MGN 472 (M)*

### Summary

Since the publication of Marine Guidance Note 472 (M) issued in November 2015 the following amendments should be noted.

Amendments are shown below in *italics*.

1. The Substantial Equivalence SE 003 listed in Annex 1 of MGN 472 should read as follows:

Ref	Description	For approval
SE003	Crew accommodation below the reference load line for <i>tugs</i> and workboats under 500GT	See MGN 491 (M)

2. The Substantial Equivalence SE 012 listed in Annex 1 of MGN 472 should read as follows:

Ref	Description	For approval
SE012	Crew accommodation requirements for large commercial yachts of 3000GT up to 5000GT	See MGN 517 (M)
