I note your longstanding constituency interest in Kneller Hall, which I know has been the home of the Royal Military School of Music (RMSM) for over \$50 years and is also home to HQ Corps of Army Music (CAMUS).

The nature of Kneller Hall as a historic listed building, and the associated planning restrictions applied to the site, are such that its use as a modern training establishment creates challenges in terms of functionality and cost. The infrastructure of Kneller Hall is also considered to be only just fit for purpose. Against this background, and taking into account the requirement to make optimum use of the Defence Estate, Project CLEF has been set up to undertake an initial high level analysis of options for the potential future location of RMSM and HQ CAMUS. This includes the option of remaining at Kneller Hall, with full or limited refurbishment, as well as other options which involve relocation to other sites. The key aim will be to ensure that RMSM and HQ CAMUS can deliver their outputs safely, effectively and efficiently.

The project is still in its early stages. The Army expects to have a better understanding of the overall timescales involved later in the summer and I will keep you informed of any significant developments.
