FOI REQUEST: DART CHARGE

Thank you for your request for information about Dart Charge dated 26 December 2014 via the DfT website under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 specifically requesting -

- The name of the European debt recovery agency of which the Highways Agency will be using for non-payment of a Dart Charge crossing by Non-UK registered vehicles and;
- 2. How this company has guaranteed that it will be able to recover fines issued to vehicles registered in France?

Our service provider Sanef are using a European Debt Recovery Agency, called Euro Parking Collection plc (EPC plc) to follow up on non-payment of Dart Charge by overseas drivers.

EPC plc have been appointed as they have significant experience in this field, and are able to effectively recover the non-payment of Dart Charge and any associated penalty charges issued thereafter in countries all across Europe, including France. They have not guaranteed, and cannot guarantee successful recovery of penalty charges in 100 per cent of cases; they have however guaranteed that all possible action will be taken.

In keeping with the spirit and effect of the legislation, all information is assumed to be releasable to the public unless exempt. We may therefore be publishing the information you requested, together with any related information that will provide a key to its wider context, via the Gov.uk website.
