### INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT TO THE MEMBERS OF

WEST BROMWICH BUILDING SOCIETY STAFF UNION

We have audited the financial statements of West Bromwich Building Society Staff Union for the year ended 31 December 2015 which comprise the Income and Expenditure Account, the Balance Sheet and the related notes.
