

This programme provides Science and Technology (S&T) research and analysis to support the UK's strategic and nuclear systems capability, including the future deterrent. It supports other Government departments with S&T research in the field of missile defence, strategic technologies and the provision of advice in strategic systems to senior decision-makers.

Working in partnership

The UK Missile Defence Centre is a joint MOD and industry initiative, funded by MOD's Chief Scientific Adviser, to enable the provision of technical and scientific advice to Government and senior policy makers on ballistic missile defence and related issues. In addition, other bespoke contracting is undertaken with suppliers in niche capability areas in direct support of the programme's aims.
