Mandatory level

Energy Efficiency	For Natural gas Boilers : Must have an Energy Efficient Rating of 88% based on SEDBUK (2009) or 90% based on SEDBUK (2005) or better under the scheme for Department for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs (Defra) / Seasonal Efficiency of Domestic Boilers in the UK.
	For LPG boilers : Must have an Energy Efficient Rating of 90% based on SEDBUK (2009)* or 92% based on SEDBUK (2005)* or better under the scheme for Department for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs (Defra) / Seasonal Efficiency of Domestic Boilers in the UK.

Best Practice Level

Energy Efficiency	In addition to the mandatory standard, all boilers must also comply with the other criteria of the Energy Saving Recommended Scheme.
	Examples of products that meet these criteria are on the Energy Saving Recommended List.
