

Dear

Thank you for your email of 19th August 2015 requesting the following information:

Can you please provide the rollout plan (date/sites/time for rollout) for the deployment of the 20 Thales NG primary surveillance radars as part of the Project MARSHALL contract?

If there are additional primary surveillance radar or radar upgrades (either Thales or other providers) to be deployed under Project MARSHALL prior to 2025, can you please provide the rollout plan (date/sites/time for rollout) for these deployments?

Can you also provide the rollout plan (date/sites/time for rollout) for the deployment of the three Thales secondary surveillance radar mentioned by Justin Barratt?

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) and as a follow on request to FOI2015/06390.

A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence (MOD), and I can confirm that information in scope of your request is held.

The information in the table is subject to the following caveats:

- (i) All of the dates and times in the table below are subject to change in accordance with the Marshall Contract, but they are correct as of 01/09/15.
- (ii) The radars under Marshall are procured over a 22 year period, however, as with most contracts the Marshall contract contains termination provisions which means the contract with Aquila could be terminated at any stage during the 22 year contract period. This may mean the service is recompeted. There are also periods during the contract period where the Authority could possibly recompete the services (the current contractor is entitled to participate in any re-competition).

If you are not satisfied with this response or you wish to complain about any aspect of the handling of your request, then you should contact me in the first instance. If informal resolution is not possible and you are still dissatisfied then you may apply for an independent internal review by contacting the Information Rights Compliance team, 1st Floor, MOD Main Building, Whitehall, SW1A 2HB (e-mail CIO-FOI-IR@mod.uk). Please note that any request for an internal review must be made within 40 working days of the date on which the attempt to reach informal resolution has come to an end.

If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not investigate your case until the MOD internal review process has been completed.
