Thank you for your email of 16 February 2016 requesting the following information:

*"The information I require under the Freedom Of Information Act is as follows:*

- *The completed survey that was conducted on my Service Families Accommodation prior to the CAAS band grading.*
- *DHS/DH+ assessment proforma and supporting evidence*
- *HHSRS risk assessment*
- *EPC or equivalent used to calculate the SAP score and EER band*
- *Noise survey as my accommodation is under the flight path for Heathrow Airport*
- *Scale assessment and supporting evidence such as measured survey drawings or calculations*
- *Pan-UK geographical classification*
- *Date of installation of carpets*
- *Dates and Details of all repairs that have taken place in the last 10 years.*
- *Date of redecoration"*

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

Please note that any request for an internal review must be made within 40 working days of the date on which the attempt to reach informal resolution has come to an end.

If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not investigate your case until the MOD internal review process has been completed.
