Operational Breathing Apparatus Wearer Assessment Course Information

Pre-course Requirements.

Prior to attending an Operational Breathing Apparatus Wearer Assessment, delegates Knowledge & Understanding requirements for each discipline are to be assessed by:

I. The successful completion of a DLE hosted training package. The printed certificate must be dated within 1 month of the course commencement and be produced on arrival. (Contract Stations to confirm with iHUBs for access).

II. Provision of evidence signed by their Fire Station Manager of having completed HLPO's 4.0 Operate as a Breathing Apparatus Wearer and 5.0 Operate as a Breathing Apparatus Entry Control Operative (BAECO).

III. Delegates are to have been trained and assessed competent on the Drager PSS 7000 Breathing Apparatus Set prior to attending DFTDC.

IV.Delegates will also provide evidence of an in-date Occupational Fire Service Medical. RAF TG8 and RN AH to provide a self-assessment of fitness as per JSP 950 Annex A Leaflet 1-2-12.

V. The course is $1\frac{1}{2}$ days duration. From 1^{st} April 2016 courses will commence at 0800 on day one and disperse at 1300 on day two.

All Personnel are to record pre-requisite requirements on **DFRMO Form 220A**.
