THE ENVIRONMENTAL PERMITTING (ENGLAND AND WALES) REGULATIONS 2010 (ASTAR WASTE LIMITED) EXERCISE OF FUNCTIONS DIRECTION 2016

The Secretary of State gives the following Direction to the Environment Agency in exercise of the power conferred by regulation 33(1)(a) of the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2010(a).

Citation and commencement

- 1.—(1) This Direction may be cited as the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2010 (Astar Waste Limited) Exercise of Functions Direction 2016.
 - (2) It comes into force on 28 January 2016.

Exercise of functions

- **2.**—(1) Functions under the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2010 in relation to the relevant operation are exercisable by the Environment Agency for an indeterminate period, unless a further direction is issued under regulation 33(1).
- (2) For the purposes of this Direction, "relevant operation" means the operation by Astar Waste Limited (company registration no: 08413347) at the premises mentioned in the Schedule of a small waste incineration plant which falls within Part B of Section 5.1 of Chapter 5 of Part 2 of Schedule 1 to the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2010(b).
