DWP response

These statistics include the number of people found fit-for-work as a result of completing a Work Capability Assessment (WCA) up to August 2012.

The unit cost to DWP of processing an ESA Appeal regardless of the outcome was £98.64 in 2011/12.

This figure is sourced from the Departmental Activity Based Management model (2011/12) and covers staffing costs only involved with the processing of an ESA appeal.
