Lincolnshire County Council (Amendment of Lindsey County Council
(Rural District of Louth) Definitive Map and Statement –
Evidential Events) (No. 1.) Modification Order 1989

Notice is hereby given that the above referenced Order has been submitted to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for determination. An Inspector will be appointed by the Secretary of State to determine the Order.

The **start date** for the above Order is **12 September 2017**.

Consideration of the Order will take the form of exchanges of statements of case and comments on statements of case.

The effect of the Order if confirmed without modification will be to modify the definitive map and statement for the area by adding thereto the undermentioned footpath:

In the Parish of Grimoldby, adding a public footpath running from the eastern end of Mill Lane, east north east along the lane and the southern boundary of OS Field No 4413 to meet public footpath No 218.

Timetable for sending in statements of case and comments

Within 2 weeks of the start date [by 26 September 2017]

The Order Making Authority must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send a copy (excluding copies of

any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) to everyone who has made an objection or representation, the applicant and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

Within 8 weeks of the start date [by 07 November 2017]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation or any other written representation must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send full copies to the Authority. Copies (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) will also be sent to the applicant, every person who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

Within the same period the applicant (if applicable) must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, Secretary of State will send a full copy to the Authority. Copies will also be sent to everyone who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices).

Within 14 weeks of the start date [by 19 December 2017]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation, the Authority, the applicant (if applicable) and anyone who has written to us in respect of the Order must ensure that their comments on any or every other statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send copies of these comments to everyone else.

Any other person wishing to make representations in writing to the Secretary of State in respect of the above Order(s) must do so in line with the timetable set out above.

In fairness to the other parties everyone should keep to the timetable to ensure that statements of case and comments are received on time. Late documents will be returned.

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 (hereinafter called "the Act") it appears to Lincolnshire County Council (hereinafter called "the surveying authority") that the Definitive Map and Statement for the area of the former Lindsey County Council (Rural District of Louth) require modification in consequence of an event specified in Section 53(3)(c)(i) of the Act namely the discovery by the surveying authority of evidence which when considered with all other relevant evidence shows that there are public footpaths over land shown in the Map and Statement

AND WHEREAS the surveying authority have consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the Order relates

NOW THEREFORE the surveying authority in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 53(2)(b) hereby make the following order:-

1. For the purposes of this Order the relevant date shall be 9 January 1989
2. The Lindsey County Council Definitive Map and Statement for the area of the former Rural District of Louth shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule and shown on the annexed map
3. This Order shall have effect on the date it is confirmed
4. This Order may be cited as the Lincolnshire County Council (Amendment of Lindsey County Council (Rural District of Louth)

Modification of Definitive Map

Description of Path to be added

In the Parish of Grimoldby

- (i) A public footpath, 2 metres in width, running generally south from Mill Lane along the path leading to St Edith's Church, entering into the Church yard, then turning east north east along a path and across OS Field No 4900, continuing north east across OS Field No 5108 to meet public footpath No 218 on the northern boundary of that field, a distance of approximately 445 metres and shown by a purple line between points A-B-C-D-E-F on annexed map No 1
- (ii) A public footpath, varying in width between 4 and 5 metres, running from the eastern end of Mill Lane, east north east along the lane and the southern boundary of OS Field No 4413 to meet public footpath No 218, a distance of approximately 125 metres and shown by a purple line between points A-B on annexed map No 2

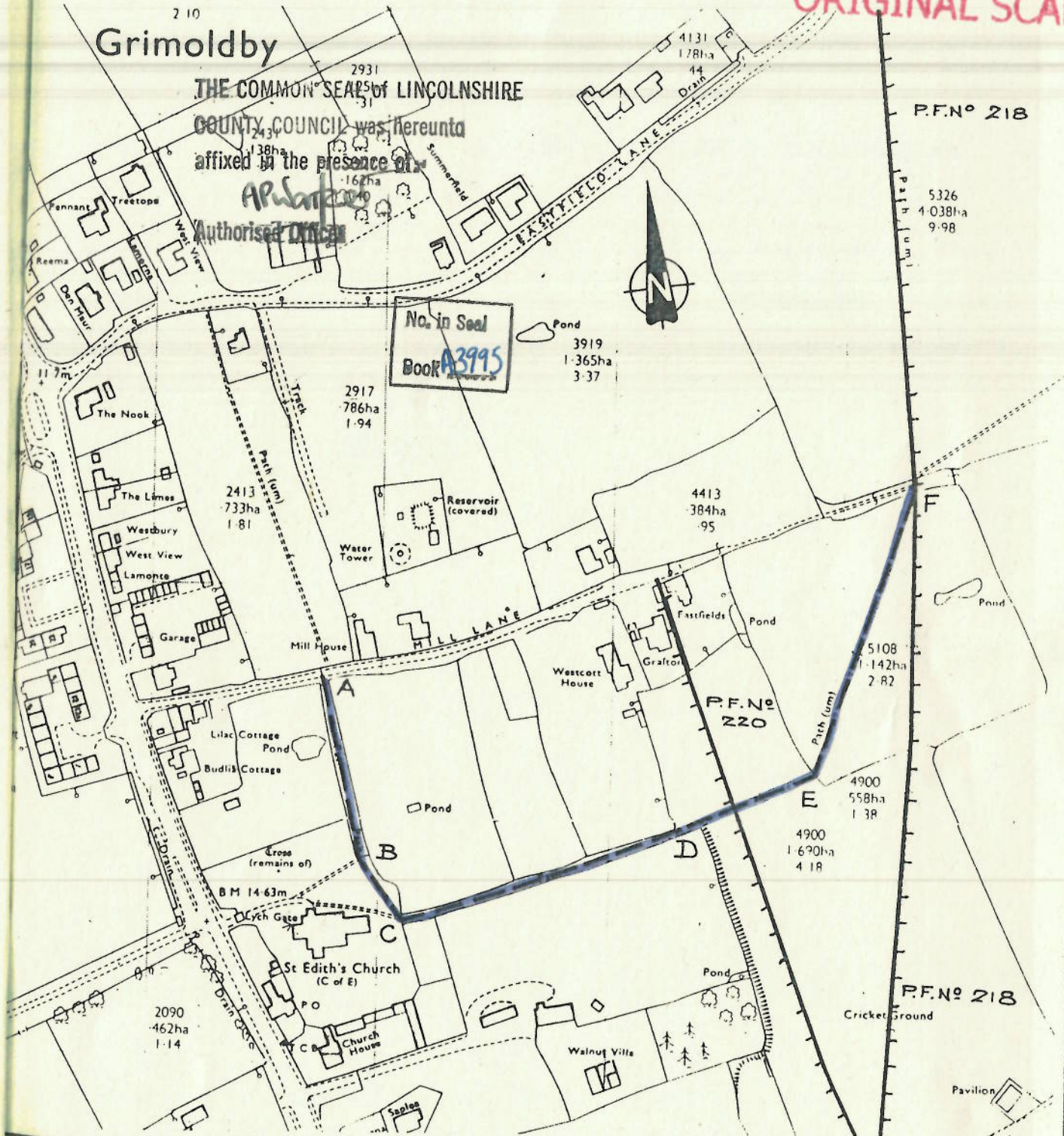
- (i) A public footpath, two metres wide, running between Mill Lane and public footpath No 218 via St Edith's Churchyard.

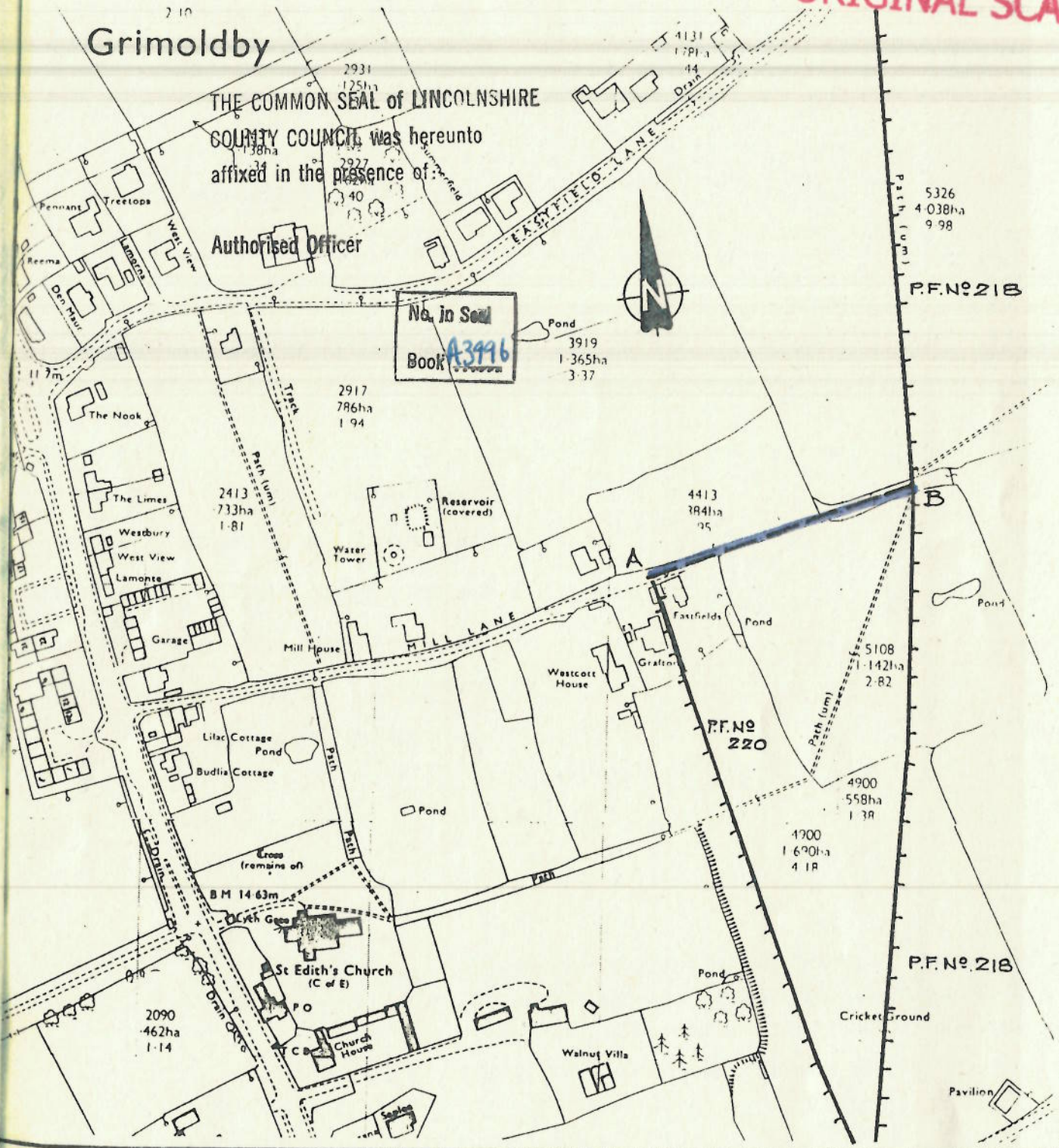
