eligible people with diabetes screened were referred with pre-proliferative retinopathy (R2M1, R2M0, R1M1)

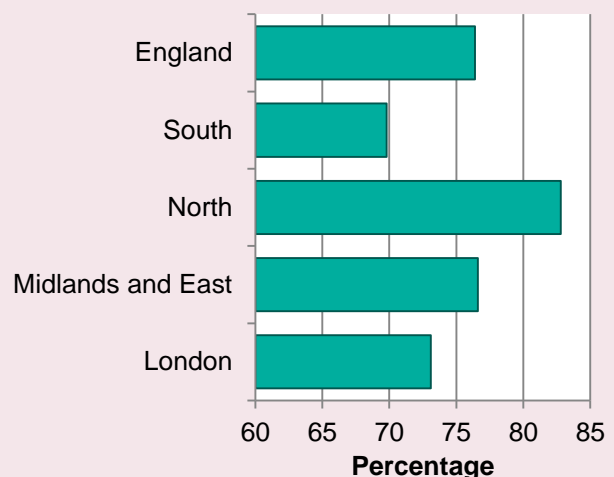
**7,255 (1 in 279)**
