FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST A14 JUNCTION 41 – MAINTENANCE AND INSPECTION RECORDS

Thank you for your email of 28 June requesting information about the inspection, maintenance and repair history of the A14 in the vicinity of junction 41 for period 1 February 2015 to the 4 July 2017. We have now completed our search for information.

Please find attached at Annexes A and B, our safety inspection records. The inspection records appear different in Annex B as our service provider changed on 1 April.

All safety inspections of the A14 are carried out with one driver and one observer present in the vehicle. The vehicle is driven at traffic flow speed at that time so not to cause any danger to other road users. Observations are predominantly carried out from lane 1 which generally moves at the slowest speed, the hard shoulder, refuge areas and overbridges may be used should they need to stop for closer observation.

If you are unhappy with the way we have handled your request you may ask for an internal review within 2 months of the date of this response.
