Thank you for your email of 15 July 2017 requesting the following information:

"I want to know when the recruitment of commonwealth citizens who haven't stayed in the UK before will be in effect."

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOI Act).

In a Written Statement on 12 May 2016, the Minister for the Armed Forces observed the long tradition of Commonwealth citizens serving in the British Armed Forces, and that their service provides an important contribution in defending the UK. The written statement confirmed that the Commonwealth recruitment rules which require five years' UK residency have therefore been reviewed.

Please note that the residency requirement was lifted immediately after the statement was made in the House, and we commenced recruiting Commonwealth citizens from summer 2016 onwards.
