## Dear Responsible Officer

## Regulation of end-point-assessments

I am writing to you regarding Ofqual's regulation of the end-point assessments (EPAs) for reformed ('standards') apprenticeships. We have decided to treat EPAs as a specific 'description of a qualification'. The effect of this decision is that no regulated awarding organisation will currently have any EPAs within its scope of recognition and should not put them on the Register. We have made EPA a distinct 'qualification type' on the Register.

We have confirmed previously that where we are part of the external quality assurance (EQA) for the EPAs in a given apprenticeship standard, we will regulate those EPAs as qualifications<sup>1</sup>. To implement this, any awarding organisation seeking to offer EPAs against these standards must now apply to bring those EPAs within its scope of recognition. The purpose of this letter is to explain what you should now do in those cases where you wish to bring a particular EPA into your scope of recognition.

The schedule attached as an annex to this letter indicates those standards where our EQA role is confirmed. You should request your extension on a standard by standard basis rather than requesting blanket extension to cover all EPAs. Where we subsequently take on an EQA role against additional standards, you will need to expand your recognition further as necessary.

For standards where we are <u>not</u> involved in the EQA, you may still want us to regulate your EPA. However, this regulation would be in addition to the assurance activity of the nominated EQA. Consequently, this would likely cause duplicative burden for you as oversight would be required from two bodies; you may therefore not wish to pursue this option.

We would ask that when you apply to expand your scope of recognition, you provide us with information, for each of the EPAs that would be in your scope of recognition, regarding:

- i) anticipated/confirmed registrations/entries for these EPAs, together with details of how these relate to your annual certifications overall; and
- ii) an indication of how advanced each EPA is in terms of its development.

This additional information will allow us to take into account your existing scope of recognition, streamlining the process to minimise burden and completing the process as swiftly as possible. We hope to make a decision on your submissions within 15 working days.
