**Explanatory notes (for a further explanation of pieces please refer to The National Archives page on <http://www.nationalarchives.gov.uk/records/citing-documents.htm> para 1.3)**

This table provides details of information which the FCO previously retained with the approval of the Lord Chancellor under Section 3(4) of the Public Records Act, and which, following re-review, we have recently transferred to The National Archives. The data in this table covers the period 1 January to 30 December 2016. We publish this data quarterly.

A 'piece' can refer to a variety of formats held by The National Archives (box, volume, roll, map, and so forth) but usually refers to a file. FCO files typically contain around 100 pages, but this can vary quite widely. Each file contains a set of documents which are often one or two pages long, but sometimes longer. An extract consists of a page (or pages) which has been removed from the file and retained, in whole or in part. An extract can consist of one or more documents.

Information retained by the FCO may comprise:

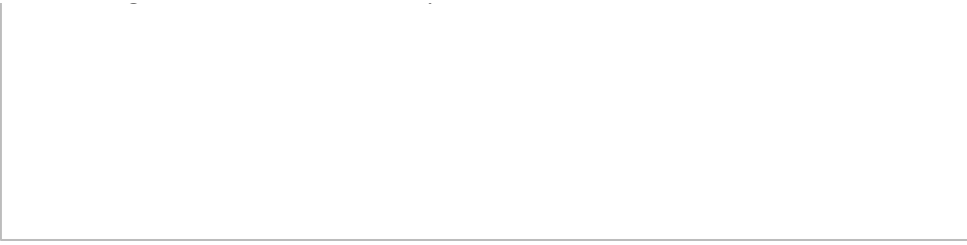
- Files retained in their entirety
- Documents retained in their entirety
- Documents retained in part (while the non-sensitive information from these documents is released)

When the FCO re-reviews retained information, it decides whether previously retained information still remains sensitive and needs to be withheld. Sometimes whole pieces or extracts are released in their entirety on re-review, sometimes all the original redactions remain in place, sometimes the number of redactions changes. Whenever the re-review of retained material results in the release of previously retained information we will list the relevant pieces or extracts in this table on a quarterly basis.

The third column in this table indicates whether the piece or extract has been sent open (without any redactions) to TNA or whether some redactions remain.

A date is given when the FCO transferred the piece or extract in question to The National Archives. However, following physical transfer from the FCO, The National Archives requires a further period in which to process the pieces or extracts before they become publicly available. The final date of release therefore depends on the work required to return the information to its proper location, the numbers of files being returned from FCO, non-related files being returned from other departments, and also the resources available.
