PROVISION OF REQUESTED INFORMATION

Thank you for your request for information about CVED's which we received on 18 December 2017. Your request has been handled under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

The information you requested and our response is detailed below:

"Information broken down by commodity code would be perfectly fine for me.

I would like information on the number of CVEDs issued for the commodity codes 02, 03, 05, 15, and 16 and if possible, the information broken down by 4-digits commodity codes.

Could you send me this information for the year 2016?"

The data requested has been extracted from Trade Control and Expert System (TRACES) through the data warehouse facility. The information that we have provided is a true reflection of the information that we have access to. APHA cannot guarantee the accuracy of this data, as we can only rely on the information that has been input into TRACES database by a third party.

Please see Appendix 1 for the number of Common Veterinary Entry Document's (CVED's) for Products of Animal Origin imported under commodity codes which begin with 02, 03, 05, 15, and 16. The data covers all CVEDs issued by the United Kingdom for these commodity codes in 2016. They include transit/transshipments, rejected consignments, and consignments destined for another EU country. The data has been broken down by the first 4 digits of the commodity code.

Where CVEDs covered more than one commodity code we have listed these (e.g. there were 9 CVEDs for which the consignment covered commodity codes beginning both 0201 and 0204).

Information disclosed in response to this FOI request is releasable to the public. In keeping with the spirit and effect of the FOIA and the government's Transparency Agenda, this letter and the information disclosed to you may be placed on GOV.UK, together with any related information that will provide a key to its wider context. No information identifying you will be placed on the GOV.UK website.
