FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000. MINISTRY OF DEFENCE POLICE: CANNABIS POSSESSION OFFENCES

I refer to your e-mail of 23 October 2017, which was acknowledged on the 24 October 2017.

We are treating your e-mail as a request for information in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA 2000).

In your e-mail you requested the following information:

"The number of people who were arrested for cannabis possession for the years 2013; 2014; 2015; 2016; and 2017 to date, and what the outcome was e.g. caution, no further action?

The number of people who spent at least 12 hours in custody following an arrest for cannabis possession for the years 2013; 2014; 2015; 2016; and 2017 to date?

I would like data relating to detainees arrested for 'possession of cannabis' related offences only (please do not include cannabis offences with intent to supply)."

A search for information has now been completed by the Ministry of Defence Police and I can confirm that we do hold information in scope of your request.

"The number of people who were arrested for cannabis possession for the years 2013; 2014; 2015; 2016; and 2017 to date, and what the outcome was e.g. caution, no further action?"
