We have now completed our search for the information you requested in your email of 4 July in relation to the A404 Marlow Bypass where it passes over Monkton Lane about 1 mile south of the M40. Your request has been dealt with under the terms of the freedom of Information Act 2000.

I will answer each of your requests for information below:

Does the Monkton Lane underpass fall under the jurisdiction of Highways England.

The Monkton Lane underpass structure is the responsibility of Highways England. But Monkton Lane, which runs beneath the A404 is the responsibility of the Buckinghamshire County Council.

Details of any and all reports received by Highways England/The Highways Agency regarding the Monkton Lane underpass on or around 17 January 2014.

An Inspection was carried out on the 20 January 2014 by a structures team for Enterprise Mouchel (the previous service provider for this area). I've attached a copy of the report for your reference. Our records show, that traffic officers attended an incident at the Handy Cross roundabout around that time. But the incident at the Monkton Lane underpass was led by Thames Valley Police.

Details of any closures of the Monkton Lane underpass on or around 17 January 2014.

Our records show that no Traffic management or closures were used during the inspection.

Details of any attendance at the Monkton Lane underpass by Highways England/The Highways Agency (including HATOs) or its agents on or around 17 January 2014.

The Enterprise Mouchel's structures team visited on the Monkton Lane underpass for the inspection on 20 January 2014.
