I am writing to confirm that we have now completed our search for the information, which you requested on 22 July 2017.

The information is below:

A speed limit of 50mph on the M6 in the vicinity of junctions 21 to 22 came into force on 4 January 2017 for safety reasons in connection with the works we are carrying out on the M62 and the link roads from the M6 onto the M62. The number of workers on the M6 since 4 January in connection with these works is zero.
