Please note: the Notice of Marriage will not be sent back to you but will be kept in indefinitely in the British Embassy in Bucharest as a permanent record of your intention to marry.	
4	Affirmation, fully completed and signed in front of a Notary Public in Romania. All your details should be exactly as they appear on your passport.

5	A photocopy of the details page of your current valid British passport	
6	A photocopy of the details page of your future spouse’s valid passport or national identity document	
7	If you are resident in Romania: proof of residence (residence permit) and equivalent documents for your partner. If you are not a resident of Romania: proof that you have been in Romania for at least 3 days immediately before sending your Notice of Marriage and affirmation to the Embassy (e.g. copy of flight information)	
8	If you or your partner have been divorced, widowed or previously in a civil partnership, you’ll also need whichever of the following documents if appropriate: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • a decree absolute or final order • a civil partnership dissolution or annulment certificate • your (or your partner’s) former spouse or civil partner’s death certificate 	

If any of your documents are not issued in the UK or Romania, consular staff may need to make further enquiries. Documents that are not written in English or Romanian will have to be translated. Romanian authorities may ask you to provide a Romanian translation of any document not in Romanian.
