The start date for the above Order is 11 April 2017.

Consideration of the Order will take the form of a hearing.

The Hearing will be held at The Nightingale Room, Elizabeth II Court, The Castle, Winchester, SO23 8UL on 15 August 2017 at 10.00am.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modifications, will be to modify the definitive map and statement for the area by adding a restricted byway commencing at a junction with Doiley Bottom and Slade Bottom Road (Point A at Grid Reference SU 4078 5227) and proceeding in a generally south-easterly then south westerly direction to a junction with Binley Bottom (Point B at Grid Reference SU 4091 5180), with a variable width of 4.5 and 10 metres for a total distance of 515 metres as shown on Order map.

# Within 8 weeks of the start date [by 06 June 2017]

The Order Making Authority must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send a copy (excluding copies of any supporting documents, although these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) to everyone who has made an objection or representation, the applicant and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

# Within 12 weeks of the start date [by 04 July 2017]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation and anyone who wishes to give evidence at the Hearing must ensure their statement of case<sup>1</sup> is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send full copies to the Authority. Copies will also be sent to the applicant, every person who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices).

Within the same period the applicant (if applicable) must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send a full copy to the Authority. Copies will also be sent to everyone who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices).

All parties must keep to the timetable set out above and ensure that statements of case are received by the Secretary of State on time. Late documents will be returned.

This Order is made by Hampshire County Council under Section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to that authority that The Hampshire Definitive Map of Public Rights of Way and The Hampshire Definitive Statement of Public Rights of Way (Dated 15<sup>th</sup> December 2007) require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in Section 53(3) (c)(i) of the Act namely:-

c) the discovery by the authority of evidence which (when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them) shows

 that a right of way which is not shown in the map and statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates, being a right of way such that the land over which the right subsists is a public path, a restricted byway or, subject to section 54A of the Act, a byway open to all traffic;

The authority has consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the Order relates.

#### Hampshire County Council hereby orders that:

- 1. For the purposes of the Order the relevant date is 3 October 2016.
- The Hampshire Definitive Map of Public Rights of Way and The Hampshire Definitive Statement of Public Rights of Way (Dated 15<sup>th</sup> December 2007) shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule as shown on the map attached to the Order.
- 3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as The Hampshire (Basingstoke and Deane Borough No. 49)(Parish of St Mary Bourne) Definitive Map Modification Order 2016.

### Modification of Definitive Map Description of path or way to be added

#### St Mary Bourne Restricted Byway 504

From grid reference SU 4078 5227 to grid reference SU 4091 5180
