I am writing to confirm that we have completed our search for the information you requested on 8 April 2017.

A copy of the information you requested is below:

You requested whether we had undertaken any air quality monitoring within the parish. We have checked our air quality monitoring records and do not have any air quality monitoring data within your parish. You may wish to check with your local council (Rother District Council, Town Hall, London Road, Bexhill on Sea, East Sussex, TN39 3JX) as to whether they have undertaken any air quality monitoring in Hurst Green as part of their Local Air Quality Management duties.

In response to your further requests these have been handled under normal business practices and not in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act/Environmental Information Regulations.

The proposed A21 speed enforcement scheme was cancelled after review of information with local police and stakeholders.

We are revisiting the original route study which identified a number of locations which could possibly benefit from engineering and technical interventions, details of our aspirations for the A21 are available in the Route Strategy Document which is available at <https://www.gov.uk/guidance/future-investment-in-englands-motorways-and-major-roads#document-library>

There are many locations across the country where trunk roads pass through villages and towns, this is by nature because the roads routes started as between conurbations. Our route strategy process does allow for such locations to be considered however all schemes have to be considered to provide a suitable benefit against cost, which includes safety, financial and environmental impacts.

If you are unhappy with the way we have handled your request you may ask for an internal review within 2 months of the date of this response for Freedom of Information requests and within 40 days for Environmental Information Regulations requests. Our internal review process is available at:
