Dear,

On reviewing my letter dated 25 August 2017 responding to your FOI request regarding the VIP Voyager I noted that I had provided inaccurate advice.

I stated that when not undertaking the VIP flights, the aircraft is routinely used in the air-to-air refuelling, air transport and troop trooping roles. This is incorrect. When not in the VIP role, Voyager ZZ336 is in the re-fuelling role but does not undertake air transport or trooping flights.

I would like to apologise for this error and for any inconvenience it has caused.
