The **start date** for the above Orders is **14 June 2017**

Consideration of the Orders will take the form of exchanges of statements of case and comments on statements of case.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modifications

Footpath 14 Great and Little Leighs

Will be to divert a part length of Footpath 14 Great and Little Leighs of unknown width commencing from a connection with Banters Lane at grid reference 57369,21787 running in a generally westerly direction through the farm yard located north of Gubbion's Hall for a total distance of approximately 158 metres to where it meets an unbridged ditch at the junction with Footpath 15 at grid reference 57353,21783, to an alternative route 2 metres in width commencing from the same above point and proceeding for a distance of approximately 26 metres in a north-westerly direction towards the corner of the telecoms mast boundary at grid reference 57367,21788 then in a south-westerly direction along an existing field-edge path along the boundary of the farm located north of Gubbion's Hall for a further distance of approximately 145 metres to the junction with Footpath 15 at grid reference 57535, 21783 where it continues unaffected as shown on the Order map contained in this Order.

Footpath 16 Great and Little Leighs

Will divert the entire length of the Footpath 16 Great and Little Leighs of unknown width commencing from a connection with Banters Lane where it adjoins the boundary of the property known as The Lilacs at grid reference 57358,21815 heading north-easterly between the boundaries of The Lilacs and the adjoining property 4 Council Cottages along a grassy track for approximately 35 metres to a point at the north west corner of the boundary of 4 Council Cottages at grid reference 573611,21818. The path continues within the garden of The Lilacs in a south-easterly

then north-easterly direction around the property's inner boundary for approximately 40 metres to the field edge at grid reference 57364,21817 then it continues across a large open field as a cross-field path heading generally north-east then south-east for a further distance of approximately 451 metres to the opposite field edge by the access track to Northwhite Cottage at grid reference 57396,21830 where it connects with Footpath 17, to an alternative route 2 metres in width commencing from a point at grid reference 57369,21800 being approximately 191 metres south-east along Banters Lane from the aforementioned commencement point running in a north-easterly direction along an existing field-edge path for approximately 279 metres to the field edge at grid reference 57385,21822 continuing as a cross-field path in a west, south-westerly direction for a further distance of approximately 96 metres where it connects with Footpath 17 on the corner of the access track to Northwhite Cottage at grid reference 57394,21820, approximately 95 metres south of its original termination as shown on the Order map contained in this Order.

Footpath 39 Great and Little Leighs

Will be to divert a path length of Footpath 39 Great and Little Leighs of unknown width commencing from a point east of house No.52 Main Road at grid reference 57257,21667 running in a south, south-easterly direction as a cross-field path and continuing in a westerly direction for a total distance of approximately 213 metres to meet the field boundary where it continues along the field edge for approximately 16 metres to connect with Footpath 38 at grid reference 57260,21647, to an alternative route 2 metres in width commencing from the same above point and proceeding in a south-westerly direction along an existing field edge path for a total distance of approximately 115 metres to a point parallel to Main Road at grid reference 57253,21656 where it connects to Footpath 38 approximately 99 metres north west of the original connection point as shown on the Order map contained in this Order.

Footpath 15 Great and Little Leighs

Will extinguish the entire length of Footpath 15 Great and Little Leighs of unknown width commencing from a connection with Banters Lane at grid reference 57370,21782 running in a westerly direction through the farm yard north of Gubbion's Hall for a total distance of approximately 162 metres to where it connects to Footpath 14 at grid reference 57535,21783 as shown on the Order map contained in this Order.

Within 8 weeks of the start date by 09 August 2017

Everyone who has made an objection or representation or any other written representation must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send full copies to the Authority. Copies (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) will also be sent to the applicant, every person who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Orders.

Within the same period the applicant (if applicable) must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, Secretary of State will send a full copy to the Authority. Copies will also be sent to everyone who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Orders (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices).

Within 14 weeks of the start date by 20 September 2017

Everyone who has made an objection or representation, the Authority, the applicant (if applicable) and anyone who has written to us in respect of the Orders must ensure that their comments on any or every other statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send copies of these comments to everyone else.

Any other person wishing to make representations in writing to the Secretary of State in respect of the above Orders must do so in line with the timetable set out above.
