

Thank you for your email of 12th October 2017 requesting the following information:

'a project directory which includes a list of subcontractors, suppliers and consultants & telephone numbers involved in the New office building comprising toilets, lift, offices, locker, shower, welfare room, waiting areas and reception; with car parking, landscaping and access.'

A search for the information has now been completed within the UKHO, and I can confirm that no information, in scope of your request is held.

Under Section 16 of the Act (Advice and Assistance) you may find it helpful to note that we have a contract with BAM Construction Ltd which covers the demolition of pre-existing site buildings, the construction of a new car park and the construction of the new Headquarters and Security buildings. BAM will manage all subcontractors reporting to them, and hold the subcontractors' details. The UKHO will not have direct contracts with these subcontractors. If you are not satisfied with this response or you wish to complain about any aspect of the handling of your request, then you should contact me in the first instance. If informal resolution is not possible and you are still dissatisfied then you may apply for an independent internal review by contacting the Information Rights Compliance team, Ground Floor, MOD Main Building, Whitehall, SW1A 2HB (e-mail CIO-FOI-IR@mod.uk). Please note that any request for an internal review must be made within 40 working days of the date on which the attempt to reach informal resolution has come to an end.

If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not investigate your case until the MOD internal review process has been completed.
