FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000. MINISTRY OF DEFENCE POLICE: MIS-FUELLING

I refer to your e-mail of 30 November 2017, which was acknowledged on the 30 November 2017.

We are treating your e-mail as a request for information in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA 2000).

In your e-mail you requested the following information:

"1. How many times in the last three years (including this current one), have police vehicles in your force been mis-fueled (i.e. diesel in a petrol vehicle or vice versa)?

2. How much did your force spend in repairs to police vehicles that have been misfueled between last three years (including this current one)?"

A search for information has now been completed by the Ministry of Defence Police and I can confirm that we do hold information in scope of your request.

1. How many times in the last three years (including this current one), have police vehicles in your force been mis-fueled (i.e. diesel in a petrol vehicle or vice versa)?

In the last three years police vehicles have been mis-fueled four times.

2. How much did your force spend in repairs to police vehicles that have been misfueled between last three years (including this current one)?

The Force has spent £7566.21in repairs to police vehicles that have been mis-fueled in the last three years.
