Thank you for your email of 8 March requesting meteorological data recorded for the last 5 years by a Highways England weather station along the A27 at Berwick, East Sussex.

I am dealing with it under the terms of the Environmental Information Regulations 2004. This is because the information requested concerns measures and activities affecting or likely to affect elements of the environment or affect factors such as noise, pollution discharges and other releases into the environment.

Please find attached the data for the weather station at A27 Berwick and the associated description sheets.

During the period requested, the site was non-operational from 16 March 2012 to 30¹ January 2013 and therefore was not reporting data at that time. However, we hope that four years plus data will be sufficient for your purposes.
