This collection has received approval from the Data Coordination Board (DCB) for the 2017 to 2018 influenza season.

1. Data is provisional and represents 98.0% of all GP practices in England responding to the December 2017 Main GP survey (purple) compared with 95.4% of practices in the same survey month in 2016/17.

2. Data is provisional and represents 97.4% of all GP practices in England responding to the December 2017 Child GP Flu Survey (green) compared with 98.1% of practices in the same survey month in 2016/17.

3. Where a total for England is quoted (e.g. sum of number of patients registered and number vaccinated) this is taken from the 98.0% GP practice sample for the main survey and 97.4% for the Child GP Flu Survey and is therefore NOT an extrapolated figure for all of England.
