The Harbours Act 1964

Scoping Opinion – Proposed Port of Barrow Harbour Revision Order.

Thank you for your letter dated 3 May 2017 to the Marine Management Organisation (“the MMO”) in which you gave notice under paragraph 3 of Schedule 3 to the Harbours Act 1964 (“the Act”).

Background

On review of the information you supplied, the MMO was of the opinion that the works proposed would require an EIA; the proposed project being one which falls within Annex II, specifically Annex II 10(e):

10(e) Construction of roads, harbours and port installations, including fishing harbours (projects not included in Annex I).

The MMO considered the project to be a relevant project within Annex II and have screened the application into the EIA process.
