- 2. RE-DETERMINATION OF THE APPLICATION BY RWE NPOWER RENEMABLES LIMITED ("RWE") DATED 11
  DECMEBR 2008 FOR CONSENT TO CONSTRUCT AND OPERATE A 130-250MW WIND TURBINE GENERATING
  STATION IN POWYS, MID WALES ("CARNEDD WEN")

I OBJECT to the applications of both of these windfarms for the reasons given in the previous round and also raised at the public inquiry and subsequent events. The windfarms should be considered accumulatively, including the transmission lines – all lines from wind farm to windfarm and back through to Shropshire. We also need to consider the residents and visitors to Shropshire, and what we are imposing on them with any new transmission lines.

Should the decision be to allow these applications to proceed, it would be very sad, as the voice of the people in Montgomeryshire (including the councils, and the MP and AM) has been consistent – a very resolute No.

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
