Recognition Process

You can apply for your product to appear on HMRC's list of recognised commercial software providers by completing the recognition process using the test scenarios below

You need to email a number of XML files generated by your application XML using the data in the test scenarios.

The SDS team will examine the XML to ensure that you have demonstrated you're your product has the ability to interact with the Transaction Engine.

The files we're looking for is a submission from a Charity or Charity Agent using the data provided below. This includes:

- Multiple lines of Donor info
- an aggregated claim
- a sponsored event claim
- a GASDS claim
- Other income details &
- an Adjustment

If your application doesn't support any of these areas please omit the data from your recognition case(s) and advise us of the limitations relating to your application.

If your software supports the submission of compressed data, please provide an xml file with these same details included as compressed data.

To demonstrate that your application can interact with the Transaction Engine in accordance with the Transaction Engine Protocol, please provide the following:

- A sample of the following message files generated by your application:
 - SUBMISSION_POLL
 - DELETE_REQUEST
 - DATA_REQUEST
- A sample of the following messages files returned by the ISV Reflector
 - SUBMISSION_ACKNOWLEDGEMENT
 - SUBMISSION_RESPONSE/ERROR
 - DELETE_RESPONSE
 - DATA_RESPONSE

Before sending the files to the SDS Team for checking, please ensure they return successful responses from the [Local Test Service \(LTS\)](#).

On receipt we'll carry out a review of the files, including testing to LTS. We'll contact you if any issues need correcting or clarifying and we'll provide guidance if any changes are necessary. Once the process has been completed we'll arrange to publish brief details of your product(s) on our website.
