PROVISION OF REQUESTED INFORMATION

Thank you for your request for information which we received on 28 June 2017. Your request has been handled under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

The information you requested and our response is detailed below:

and can see that these tables are running 3 months late, but in the latest version to the end of March 2017 there are 30,079 cattle slaughtered, as at cell 'L34' of the ENGLAND page.

MY FOI request is as follows: For these 12 months, ie summing to 30,079 overall, please can you supply the numbers of cattle that fit into each of the categories of the valuation tables as seen at, for example,

Please see Appendices 1 and 2 for the information you have requested.

The report was run for the same period as requested, 1 April 2016 to 31 March 2017 and the sum figure now produced is 30082 as opposed to the figure published previously of 30079.

APHA cannot identify which 3 animals have been added since publication so we have based this response on the 30082 now recorded on our internal system, called SAM.

There are 137 animals in herds that are not classified as Beef or Dairy so they are not included in the Appendices. Hence the breakdown of figures is based on the sum of 29945.

The Animal and Plant Health Agency is an Executive Agency of the Department for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs working to safeguard animal and plant health for the benefit of people, the environment and the economy.

These 137 animals are recorded in SAM as Approved Finishing Unit (AFU) herds, Licensed Finishing Unit (LFU) herds, temporary gathering and calf rearer.

Information disclosed in response to this FOI request is releasable to the public. In keeping with the spirit and effect of the FOIA and the government's Transparency Agenda, this letter and the information disclosed to you may be placed on GOV.UK, together with any related information that will provide a key to its wider context.
