Request for Information

Thank you for your email dated 2 November 2016 requesting information on the Multidisciplinary framework. For ease of reference your request is below:

"I am writing to request a project directory which includes a list of subcontractors, suppliers and consultants & telephone numbers involved in the Multi-disciplinary demolition framework to include demolition, ACM removal and asbestos surveys and reporting."

We have now had an opportunity to investigate your request and are writing to communicate our response. Attached to this letter are two spreadsheets. The first spreadsheet is a consortium matrix, which along the top lists the Lead Panel members and below each entry are the sub-consultants used by each Lead Panel member. The sub-consultants used by each Lead Panel member are denoted by the corresponding cell of the spreadsheet being coloured red with a cross in it.

Please note: any demolition work not consultancy based or ACM removal would be procured through contracts finder as the Multidisciplinary Panel is only for consultancy services.

The second spreadsheet is a list of contact details for the Lead Panel firms. We have made redactions where the information contained is personal data. These redactions have been made under s40(2) Freedom of Information Act 2000.

Section 40(2) – Personal Data of a third party

Section 40(2) of the Act permits a public authority to withhold information where disclosure would be in breach of any of the Principles of the Data Protection Act. Disclosure of certain information within the documents would be likely to breach the First Data Protection Principle, as it would exceed the Data Subjects' expectations as to how their information would be processed. This exemption is absolute and therefore no public interest test needs to be carried out to apply the exemption.
