

NOTICE OF PROPOSAL TO MODIFY DEFINITIVE MAP ORDER

WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981

Notice is hereby given pursuant to paragraph 8(2) of Schedule 15 to the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 that the Inspector appointed by the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs to determine the Cornwall Council (Addition of Restricted Byway from road U6036 to Bridleway 62 Camborne) (Penponds) Modification Order 2016 proposes to modify the Order by providing for the following modifications:

- Throughout the Order:
- replace text "...restricted byway..." with text "...footpath...";
- Within Part II of the Schedule:
- add box for 'Maximum width' at "5 metres" adding a note that this is "*In accordance with the depiction of the way on map sheet Cornwall LXII.16 from the Ordnance Survey County Series Second Edition published at 1:2500 scale.*"
- On Order map:
- alter the line to show the route as a footpath between points A and B, by a continuous line with short bars at intervals;
- alter the key to show footpath.

A copy of the Order as submitted and a copy of the Order showing the proposed modifications together with the Inspector's Order decision dated 3 August 2017 have been deposited at Cornwall Council Reception, Pydar House, Pydar Street, Truro, Cornwall, TR1 1XU and Cornwall Council Reception, Dolcoathe Avenue, Camborne, Cornwall, TR14 8SX and may be inspected free of charge during normal working hours.
