Notice is hereby given that the above referenced Orders have been submitted to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for determination. An Inspector will be appointed by the Secretary of State to determine the Orders.

The **start date** for the above Orders is **4 August 2017**.

Consideration of the Orders will take the form of a public local inquiry.

The Inquiry will be held at **The Reading Room, Stratford Road, Stratford Sub Castle, Salisbury, Wiltshire, SP1 3LL** on **Tuesday 23 January 2018** at 10.00am.

The effect of the first Order, if confirmed without modifications, will be to divert part of footpath Salisbury no. 6 at Stratford sub Castle from its existing line to the rear of residential properties (width 2 metres to 2.14 metres approx length 321 metres) to a path to the north east leading from OS Grid ref SU 1339 3223 to OS Grid ref SU 1320 3248 (width 3 metres approx length 326 metres) and to alter the City of Salisbury Area definitive map and statement dated 1953 accordingly.

The effect of the second Order, if confirmed without modifications, will be to extinguish the public footpath running from OS Grid ref SU1320 3248 to OS Grid ref SU 1338 3223 (linking Salisbury path no 6 with Salisbury path no 24) at Stratford sub Castle. Width 2 metres. Approx. length 323 metres.

### <u>Timetable for sending in statements of case and proofs of evidence</u>

#### Within 8 weeks of the start date by [by 29 September 2017]

The Order Making Authority must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send a copy (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) to everyone who has made an objection or representation and the applicant and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Orders.

#### Within 14 weeks of the start date [by 10 November 2017]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation and anyone who wishes to give evidence at the Inquiry must ensure their statement of case<sup>1</sup> is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send full copies to the Authority. Copies will also be sent to the applicant, every person who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Orders (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices).

Within the same period the applicant (if applicable) must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send a full copy to the Authority. Copies will also be sent to everyone who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Orders (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices).

#### 4 weeks before the date of the inquiry [by 22 December 2017]

The Authority, everyone who has made an objection or representation, the applicant (if applicable) and anyone who wishes to give evidence at the Inquiry must ensure their proof of evidence (together with any summary) is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send copies of:

i) the Authority's proof of evidence to everyone who has made an objection or representation, the applicant and anyone who has submitted a statement of case (excluding copies of any supporting




Extinguishment of Unrecorded footpath at Stratford sub Castle Salisbury

The Wiltshire Council City of Salisbury (Stratford sub Castle) Salisbury footpath no. 6

This Order is made by Wiltshire Council ("the authority") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

This order is also made under section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the 1981 Act") because it appears to the authority that the City of Salisbury Area definitive map and statement dated 1953 as modified under the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(a)(i) of the 1981 Act, namely the diversion (as authorised by this Order) of a highway shown or required to be shown in the map and statement.

Salisbury City Council have been consulted as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

#### BY THIS ORDER

- The public footpath over the land situate at Stratford sub Castle and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this order shall be stopped up after 7 days from the date of confirmation of this order, and thereupon the City of Salisbury area definitive map dated 1953 shall be modified by deleting from it that public right of way.
- 2. There shall be at the end of 7 days from the date of confirmation of this order be a public footpath over the land situate at Stratford sub Castle and as described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a broken line on the map contained in this order, and thereupon the City of Salisbury area definitive map dated 1953 shall be modified by adding that path to it.
- The City of Salisbury area definitive statement shall be modified as described in part 3 of the Schedule to this Order.
