<b>DESCRIPTION OF SITE:</b> A small area of open heathland surrounded by a mixture of deciduous and coniferous woodland. It is a satellite site of the main STANTA training area, positioned to the south west of the main Danger Area.  <b>HECTARAGE OF DIRECTION:</b> 28.23					
<b>DESCRIPTION OF MILITARY USE:</b> This area of land is designated as a live firing Danger Area. It is a 'remote firing point' used to fire artillery shells into the impact area within the main Danger Area. It is also used as a dry training area and is a communication training point.					
<b>CURRENT PUBLIC ACCESS:</b> A public footpath runs along the southern edge of the site from the road through to the English Heritage Grimes Graves area. Under local orders red flags are flown and sentries are placed at either end of this path during live firing to ensure public safety and enable military training to take place. There is no intention to further restrict public access to this site.					
<b>ORIGINAL S28 JUSTIFICATION:</b>  1. The habitat criteria for CROW mapping created the situation where a live firing danger area was mapped as access land. It continues to be MOD policy that all land within any Danger Area must be subject to restriction in the interest of clarity and public safety.  2. MOD intends to create byelaws for this area under the current byelaw review programme resulting in this land being permanently excepted from CROW access legislation. Any proposals for byelaws will be subject to public consultation.					
<b>REVIEW COMMENTS:</b>  The Military Use section is still relevant. The original s28 justification remains valid and there is a continued need for a s28 CROW direction.
