WFP SUDAN OPERATION IN FIGURES

Under the Protracted Relief and Recovery Operation (PRRO), WFP plans to provide food assistance to 6.1 million conflict-affected and food insecure people, including IDPs, refugees, malnourished children, pregnant and lactating women and school-aged children – of which 69% are in Darfur.

From January to June 2017:

- WFP plans to assist 3.4 million people in Sudan through general food distribution (GFD), school feeding to address short term hunger and stabilize enrolment which includes takehome rations to increase girls' attendance, targeted supplementary feeding, blanket supplementary feeding for emergency situations, and food-assistance-for-assets (FFA) and food-for-training (FFT) activities.
- 1.9 million will receive GFD, including 1.3 million IDPs in Darfur. 470,300 individuals will receive cash-based transfers (CBT) which will enable families to select from 14 food items which they can 'buy' directly from traders, thereby stimulating markets and boosting local economy.
- 985,300 people will participate in FFA and FFT activities. FFA will play a substantial role in WFP's transition from status to vulnerability-based assistance as the findings of the IDP profiling exercise, which categorizes beneficiaries into vulnerability categories, are gradually implemented throughout 2015 and finalised in early 2016.
- **548,300** individuals receiving GFD and participating in FFA/FFT will receive cash-based transfers.
- 1 million school children will participate in WFP school feeding activities ensuring daily food consumption.



South Sudan Humanitarian Response

- According to UNHCR figures, 263,245 South Sudanese have been displaced into Sudan since the onset of the civil conflict in South Sudan.
- Under the PRRO, WFP will continue to provide general food assistance as well as emergency nutritional services to new arrivals in the border states with no access to food sources.
- Since December 2013, WFP has provided 243,800 refugees from South Sudan with general food assistance, emergency blanket supplementary feeding and targeted supplementary feeding, mainly across White Nile, South Kordofan, West Kordofan North Kordofan, East Darfur and South Darfur States.
