

NOTICE OF ORDER WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981 SECTION 53

NORTHUMBERLAND COUNTY COUNCIL DEFINITIVE MAP MODIFICATION ORDER (NO 6) 2012 PUBLIC BRIDLEWAYS NOS 45 AND 46 (PARISH OF ELSDON)

Notice is hereby given that the above referenced Order has been submitted to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for determination. An Inspector will be appointed by the Secretary of State to determine the Order.

The **start date** for the above Order is **17 May 2017**.

Consideration of the Order will take the form of exchanges of statements of case and comments on statements of case.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modifications, will be to modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by:-

Former Alnwick District

Public Bridleway No 45 (Parish of Elsdon)

Adding thereto a public bridleway, from a point marked C, on existing Bridleway No 5, 10 metres west of Hillhead Cottage in a north-westerly then easterly direction for a distance of 655 metres, to point marked F, on the C187 road, 420 metres north of Hillhead Cottage.

Public Bridleway No 46 (Parish of Elsdon)

Adding thereto a public bridleway, from a point marked A, on the A696 road, opposite that road's junction with Bridleway No 36 (Parish of Otterburn), 450 metres south-east of Blaxter Cottages, in a general northerly then easterly direction for a distance of 1635 metres to a point marked B on existing Bridleway No 5, 10 metres west of Hillhead Cottage.

Timetable for sending in statements of case and comments

Within 2 weeks of the start date [by 31 May 2017]

The Order Making Authority must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send a copy (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) to everyone who has made an objection or representation, the applicant and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

Within 8 weeks of the start date [by 12 July 2017]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation or any other written representation must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send full copies to the Authority. Copies (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) will also be sent to the applicant, every person who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

Within the same period the applicant (if applicable) must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, Secretary of State will send a full copy to the Authority. Copies will also be sent to everyone who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices).

Within 14 weeks of the start date [by 23 August 2017]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation, the Authority, the applicant (if applicable) and anyone who has written to us in respect of the Order must ensure that their comments on any or every other statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send copies of these comments to everyone else.

Any other person wishing to make representations in writing to the Secretary of State in respect of the above Order(s) must do so in line with the timetable set out above.

In fairness to the other parties everyone should keep to the timetable to ensure that statements of case and comments are received on time. Late documents will be returned.

Definitive Map Modification Order (No 6) 2012

Public Bridleways Nos 45 & 46 (Parish of Elsdon)

This Order is made by Northumberland County Council under Section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to that authority that the Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for the County of Northumberland require modification in consequence of the occurrence of events specified in Section 53(3)(c)(i)(ii) and (iii), namely, the discovery by the authority of evidence which (when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them) shows that a right of way which is not shown in the map and statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates, being a right of way such that the land over which the right subsists is a public path, a restricted byway or, subject to section 54A, a byway open to all traffic; that a highway shown in the map and statement as a highway of a particular description ought to be there shown as a highway of a different description; and that there is no public right of way over land shown in the map and statement as a highway of any description, or any other particulars contained in the map and statement require modification.

The authority has consulted every local authority whose area includes the land to which the order relates. The Northumberland County Council hereby order that:

1. For the purposes of this Order the relevant date is 1 June 2012.
2. The Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for the County of Northumberland shall be modified as described in the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the Order.
3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as The Northumberland County Council Definitive Map Modification Order (No 6) 2012.

Definitive Map Modification Order (No 6) 2012

Description of Modification to Definitive Map and Statement

Former Alnwick District

Elsdon **Footpath No 13** **(NY 99 SW)**

Part I Map: Deleting thereto the public footpath, from a point marked E, 290 metres east of Redshaw, in a general easterly direction for a distance of 215 metres, to a point marked F, on the C187 road, 420 metres north of Hillhead Cottage. This deletion is a consequence of the upgrading of this section of footpath to public bridleway (BR 45) status.

Part II Statement: To be amended as follows:
From Bridleway No 5 at Knightside in a north-easterly direction, crossing Footpath No 14, by Redshaw and crossing Footpath No 15 and the Shaw Cleugh to join Public Bridleway No 45, 290 metres east of Redshaw.

Elsdon **Footpath No 16** **(NY 99 SW)**

Part I Map: Deleting thereto the public footpath, from a point marked C, 10 metres west of Hillhead Cottage in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 75 metres, to a point marked D, 85 metres north-west of Hillhead Cottage. This deletion is a consequence of the upgrading of this section of footpath to public bridleway (BR 45) status.

Part II Statement: To be amended as follows:
From Bridleway No 45, 85 metres north-west of Hillhead Cottage, in a general north-westerly direction to join the Elsdon Bridge - Harwood Heads road west of Starmyers Cottage.

Elsdon **Bridleway No 18** **(NY 99 SW)**

Part I Map: The map is unaffected.

Part II Statement: To be amended as follows:
From the Otterburn - New Houses road (A.696) north-east of Liberty Hill in a north-easterly direction crossing the Raven's Cleugh, by Ravenscleugh, crossing the footbridge over the Raylees Burn and by Burnhead, and crossing Public Bridleway No 46, to join Bridleway No 5 at Hillhead.

Elsdon**Public Bridleway No 45****(NY 99 SW)**

Part I Map:

Adding thereto a public bridleway, from a point marked C, on existing Bridleway No 5, 10 metres west of Hillhead Cottage in a north-westerly then easterly direction for a distance of 655 metres, to a point marked F, on the C187 road, 420 metres north of Hillhead Cottage.

Part II Statement:

To be prepared as follows:

A 3 metre wide public bridleway, from Bridleway No 5, 10 metres west of Hillhead Cottage in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 445 metres, then in an easterly direction for a distance of 210 metres, to join the C187 road, 420 metres north of Hillhead Cottage.

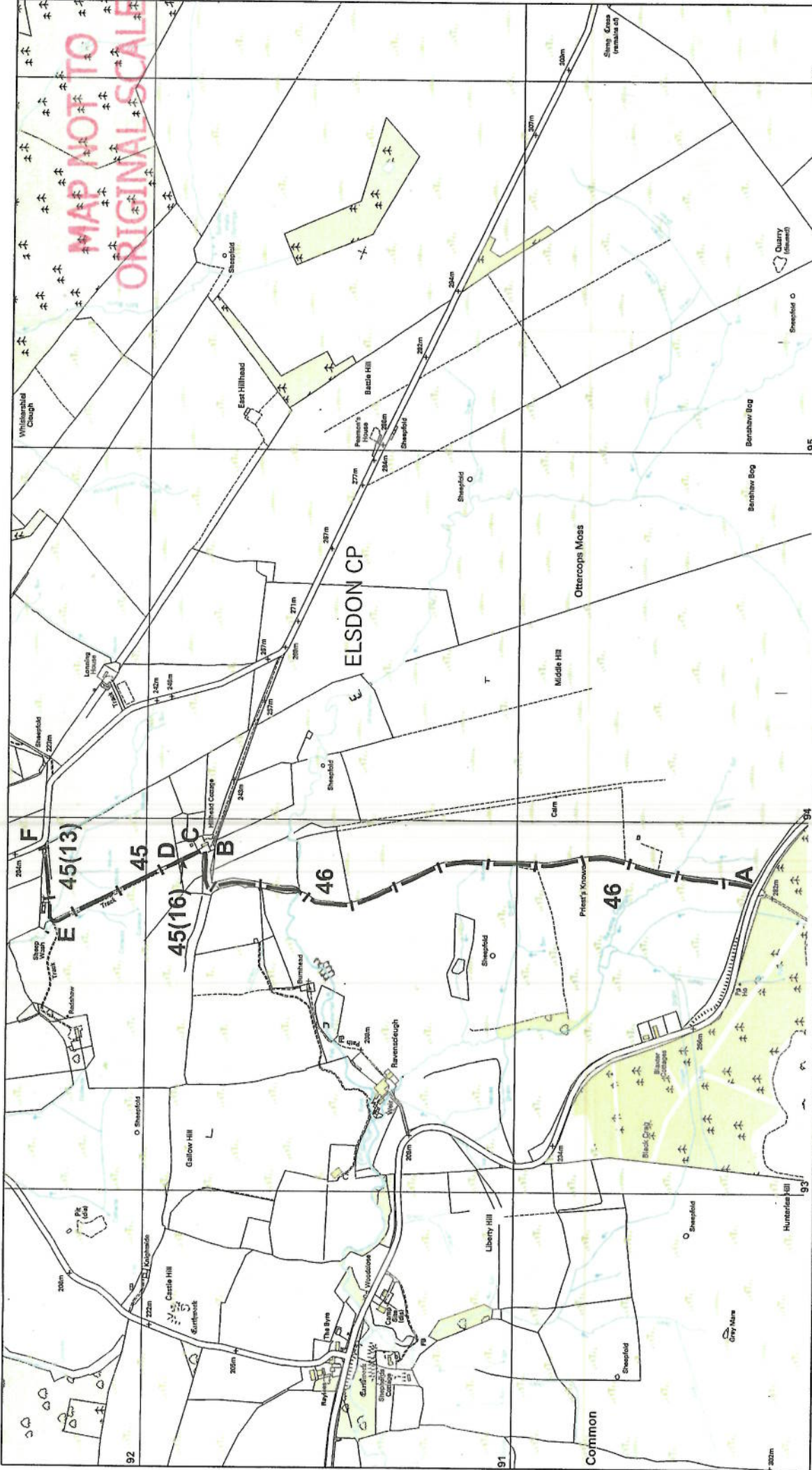
Part I Map:

Adding thereto a public bridleway, from a point marked A, on the A696 road, opposite that road's junction with Bridleway No 36 (Parish of Otterburn), 450 metres south-east of Blaxter Cottages, in a general northerly then easterly direction for a distance of 1635 metres to a point marked B on existing Bridleway No 5, 10 metres west of Hillhead Cottage.

Part II Statement:

To be prepared as follows:

A 3 metre wide public bridleway, from the A696 road, opposite that road's junction with Bridleway No 36 (Parish of Otterburn), 450 metres south-east of Blaxter Cottages, in a general northerly direction for a distance of 1530 metres, and crossing Raven's Cleugh and the Raylees Burn, then in an easterly direction for a distance of 105 metres to join Bridleway No 5, 10 metres west of Hillhead Cottage.
