Unrest in Libya – dealing with enquiries from Libyan nationals studying in the UK

Introduction

Libyan nationals currently studying at United Kingdom (UK) universities are generally funded by the Libyan government or their family in Libya. Their immigration status is that they have limited leave to remain in the UK with no recourse to public funds. As such, they cannot claim Housing Benefit (HB) or Council Tax Benefit (CTB).

Dealing with enquiries about access to HB and CTB

At present, funds should still be available to Libyan students despite the current unrest in Libya. Therefore, anyone who approaches a local authority for help with their rent or Council Tax should be advised to contact their bank or the Libyan Embassy in the first instance.

No funds available
