Simon,

On Egypt, Bob Dudley will be hosting an inauguration event for our West Nile Delta investments, Taurus and Libra, on ca. May 8<sup>th</sup>/9<sup>th</sup> and support from the highest levels in HMG would be greatly appreciated. The exact details are to be finalised subject to attendance.

[These BP-operated, conventional gas projects are located offshore in the West Nile Delta, and are the first two of five fields that BP is bringing into development. BP holds an interest of 83% in these two projects and it is foreseen that they will have a peak production of approximately 100 mboed (thousand barrels of oil equivalent per day). In total, they are expected to develop five trillion cubic feet of gas resources and 55 million barrels of condensates.

These projects are of major significance to BP as Egypt is rapidly becoming a significant component of BP's portfolio.

On 2 March, Chancellor Merkel attended the inauguration of the first phase of Siemens' megaproject to build new power plants in Egypt. Her visit was extremely well-received, and I am sure that a UK VVIP attendance at our inauguration in May will be just as warmly welcomed.
