I am writing to confirm that, following a search for the information you requested on 28 July 2017 and sent further clarification on 25 August 2017, we are unable to provide you with a link to, or a report on, the Air Quality Monitoring data at this time.

The point you clarified was in relation to the following statement:

“Under data sharing good practice this data should be publically available and viewable. Where is it?”

In response to our request for clarification as to the underpinning document about “data sharing good practice” you provided us with a link to a Government Policy Paper entitled “Government Transformation Strategy: better use of data”. A copy of this report can be found here.

Highways England is currently completing the installation of the National Air Quality Monitoring Network. Whilst this work is ongoing, we are considering options around how we may make data available in the future. As work is ongoing, we are unable to provide you with a link to the monitoring data at this time.
