FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000 - REQUEST REF: FOI 0623-17

Thank you for your email of 26 June 2017 asking for information under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) 2000. You asked:

“Please can you let me have the following information to be included in my request for support.

How many British tourists died in Goa in 2016, 2015, 2014, 2013, 2012, 2011, 2010 and 2009. I understand the figure is approximately one per week but need confirmation.

Can you also facilitate the number of successful prosecution in any of these deaths or are they all classed as accidental.”

Outcome of search

I am writing to confirm that we have now completed our search and I can confirm that the Foreign and Commonwealth Office (FCO) does hold some information relevant to your request.

Disclosure

Please find below the information held to which you are entitled under the FOIA. The figures below are for all those British national (visitors) who died in Goa where the FCO was made aware of their death.
