Definitive Map Modification Order (No 12) 2016 Byways Open to All Traffic
Nos 26 and 27 (Parishes of Craster & Rennington)

Notice is hereby given that the above referenced Order has been submitted to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for determination. An Inspector will be appointed by the Secretary of State to determine the Order.

The **start date** for the above Order is **2 November 2017**.

Consideration of the Order will take the form of a hearing.

The Hearing will be held at "Ashington" meeting room, County Hall, Morpeth, Northumberland, NE61 2EF on Wednesday 14 March 2018 at 10.00am.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modifications, will be to modify the definitive map and statement for the area by:-

#### **Former Alnwick District**

#### Byway Open to All Traffic No 27 (Parish of Rennington)

Adding thereto a byway open to all traffic, from a point marked Q, on the B1339 road, 750 metres west of Dunstan Hill Farm, in a general northeasterly direction along part of the U3016 road for a distance of 325 metres, to a point marked R, on alleged Byway Open to All Traffic No 26 in the Parish of Craster, 495 metres north-west of Dunstan Hill Farm.

#### Byway Open to All Traffic No 26 (Parish of Craster)

Adding thereto a byway open to all traffic, from a point marked R, on alleged Byway Open to All Traffic No 27 in the Parish of Rennington, 495 metres north-west of Dunstan Hill Farm, in an easterly, general southeasterly then easterly direction along part of the U3016 road for a distance of 1115 metres, to a point marked S, on the C74 road, 460 metres east of Dunstan Hill Farm.

### Timetable for sending in statements of case

#### Within 8 weeks of the start date [by 28 December 2017]

The Order Making Authority must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send a copy (excluding copies of any supporting documents, although these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) to everyone who has made an objection or representation, the applicant and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

#### Within 12 weeks of the start date [by 25 January 2018]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation and anyone who wishes to give evidence at the Hearing must ensure their statement of case<sup>1</sup> is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send full copies to the Authority. Copies will also be sent to the applicant, every person who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices).

Within the same period the applicant (if applicable) must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send a full copy to the Authority. Copies will also be sent to everyone who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices).

All parties must keep to the timetable set out above and ensure that statements of case are received by the Secretary of State on time. Late documents will be returned.

# Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for the County of Northumberland

Byways Open to All Traffic Nos 26 and 27 (Parishes of Craster & Rennington)

This Order is made by Northumberland County Council under Section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to that authority that the Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for the County of Northumberland require modification in consequence of the occurrence of events specified in Section 53(3)(c)(i) and (iii), namely, the discovery by the authority of evidence which (when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them) shows that a right of way which is not shown in the map and statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates, being a right of way such that the land over which the right subsists is a public path, a restricted byway or, subject to section 54A, a byway open to all traffic; and that there is no public right of way over land shown in the map and statement as a highway of any description, or any other particulars contained in the map and statement require modification.

The authority has consulted every local authority whose area includes the land to which the order relates. The Northumberland County Council hereby order that:

- For the purposes of this Order the relevant date is 1 April 2016.
- The Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for the County of Northumberland shall be modified as described in the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the Order.
- This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as The Northumberland County Council Definitive Map Modification Order (No 12) 2016.

As a 5 metre wide byway open to all traffic, from Byway Open to All Traffic No 27 in the Parish of Rennington, at a 3 metre wide enclosed culvert over the Stamford Cast, 495 metres north-west of Dunstan Hill Farm, in an easterly direction for a distance of 280 metres. Thereafter as a 5 to 5.5 metre wide byway in a southerly direction for a distance of 115 metres. Thereafter as a 5 metre wide byway continuing in a southerly direction for a distance of 35 metres, then in an easterly direction for a distance of 25 metres. Thereafter as a 7 – 8 metre wide byway in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 30 metres. Thereafter as an 8 to 9 metre wide byway in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 100 metres. Thereafter as a 6 metre wide byway continuing in a south-easterly direction for a further 60 metres. Thereafter as an 8 to 8.5 metre wide byway in an easterly direction for a distance of 470 metres to join the C74 road, 460 metres east of Dunstan Hill Farm.



Thereafter as an 8 to 8.5 metre wide byway, continuing in a north-easterly direction for a further 85 metres. Thereafter as a 5 metre wide byway open to all traffic, continuing in a north-easterly direction for a further 95 metres to join Byway open to All Traffic No 26 in the Parish of Craster, at a 3 metre wide enclosed culvert over the Stamford

Cast, 495 metres north-west of Dunstan Hill Farm.
